**You are invited** to prepare for Pentecost by opening your mind and heart to the Lord through vibrant and engaging presentations by Father Timothy Cremeens in which he'll describe what has led to the Spirit-driven new springtime that the Church is experiencing, and how we can build a culture of Pentecost to support the New Evangelization.

As we pray, listen and share, we will ask the Lord to:

- Inspire us with a fresh awareness of the power and creativity of the Holy Spirit
- Imbue more deeply within us a culture of Pentecost
- Increase our awareness of past mistakes, so that we don't repeat them
- Invigorate our praise of the Lord as we show our gratitude for His mercy in this Golden Jubilee of the CCR
- Give us the zeal and urgency to evangelize as missionary disciples of Jesus Christ
- Reveal to us how we can be better promoters of authentic Christian unity

**Our Formation Day will include several presentations by Fr Timothy Cremeens, as well as a Question-and-Answer session with him.** Our prayer time together and our fellowship during this time will be opportunities to deepen our relationships with one another.

**Father Timothy Cremeens Ph.D.,** is a Priest in the Orthodox Church of America. He became the Pastor and Dean of Holy Resurrection Cathedral, Wilkes Barre in 2014. Ordained a Deacon in 1991 and a Priest in 1992, Fr Timothy has served as pastor of St George (Antiochian) Orthodox Church Church (1992-1997) in Danbury, CT; founding pastor of Holy Trinity (Antiochian) Orthodox Church (1997-2004) in Little Rock, AR; assistant pastor of St Basil's (Antiochian) Orthodox Church (2004-2009) in Poquoson, VA & pastor of St Mary's Assumption (Albanian OCA) Orthodox Church (2009-2013) in Worcester, MA. He is a graduate of Colorado State University (1990) with a B.A. in History, from St. Vladimir's Orthodox Theological Seminary (1993) with an M.Div., and from Regent University School of Divinity (2011) with a Ph.D. in Church History. Fr Timothy has taught Bible and Church History at several universities and seminaries, including King's College in Wilkes-Barre. He has served as a spiritual advisor to a chapter of the Orthodox Christian Fellowship (OCF) college ministry, a Hospice Chaplain and the Director of the Washburn House Hospice Residential Center. He is a member of the Orthodox Theological Society of America, the Society for Pentecostal Studies, the Ecumenical Society of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Christian Churches Gathered and a board member of the International Fellowship of the Communities of Jesus.

**Our day of formation will be held at The Holy Family Spiritual Renewal Center located just outside Nanticoke.** An overnight stay is available for those who wish to travel on Friday evening. The accommodations are designed for double occupancy. Each set of two bedrooms shares a common bathroom. Linens and towels are provided.

The Center has a chapel, a kitchen, a dining room, a library, a fireplace sitting room, and a large meeting room. Out of sensitivity to other guests, smoking is not permitted in the Center.

Registration and breakfast start at 8:00 on Saturday morning, and the main program will begin at 9:00. Our day will end with a supper early Saturday evening. The requested donation amounts are: **\$25** program registration fee per person (fee includes 3 meals on Saturday); overnight accommodations (double occupancy) would be an additional **\$25** per person.

## Directions to the Holy Family Center:

Take the Nanticoke/Route 29 exit (#164) off I-81.

This will put you on Route 29.

Pass the Ashley/Sugar Notch exit (#1).

Pass the Alden exit (#2).

Take the Nanticoke exit (#3).

Turn left at the end of the ramp.

Follow this road (Main St) as it enters the town of Nanticoke.

Go straight through the two traffic lights in Nanticoke.

After the 2<sup>nd</sup> light (at Burger King),

follow Main St up a hill,

then down a steeper hill.

After passing a Turkey Hill on your right,

you'll go up another hill.

At the fork at the top of this hill, bear to the right onto Old

Newport St.

In just a short distance, you'll see the former

Holy Child Church on your left,

and the new apartments (an old school building) right next to it.

The driveway for the Holy Family Center is between the

apartment building and the Guardian Eldercare nursing home.

There's a small sign that reads "Holy Family Center" at the

beginning of the driveway.

Follow the driveway until it ends in the Holy Family Center's

parking lot.

(The Holy Family Center has a large mural of St Francis on the

outside)

When you arrive for a scheduled event, go right in...you don't

need to ring the bell.

The Holy Family Center is owned by Martin Hudak, and is run by

Michael & Joyce Hudak.
